 - SEND Information Report
- Meet with school link once a term to monitor inclusion and equality performance including progress towards achieving the Equality Objectives and the objectives set out in the Accessibility Plan.
- Provide a termly update to the Governing Body on progress with the Equality Objectives.
- ➤ Together with the school link, provide an Annual SEND Report and review of progress with the Accessibility Plan to the Governing Body at the end of the school year.
- Together with the school link, ensure that SEND Information Report and the relevant inclusion and equality information is published on the school website.
- Monitor school response in regard to any alleged discrimination incidents.
