

## Key Stage 2 SATS results 2013:

The SATS results from 2013 were based on externally marked test results for mathematics, reading and the new grammar, punctuation and spelling test. On-going moderated teacher assessments are used for writing and science. The national expectation is for a child in Year 6 to achieve level 4 in all subject areas (Maths, English and Science). Below are two tables detailing the results achieved by our Year 6 class in 2013:
