



On Tuesday, Nat Felton is visiting us. Nat is blind and will visit the school with his guide dog called Kirk. He will speak to children about being blind and how he lives his life without being able to see. Children will have the opportunity to meet the dog up close if they want to. No child will be asked to go and stroke or go near the dog by an adult. Obviously, guide dogs are well trained and picked for their calm temperament. We are very much looking forward to the visit.

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

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Brilliant Birds

Paper Engineering Challenge

A fun, practical STEM competition for Hertfordshire primary school children for British Science Week 2019

The Challenge:

- Children create their own bird
- Use a given number of card squares of different sizes (templates will be provided)
- Use only pritt-stick style glue to make your bird, and only pen/pencil to decorate so it can be recycled afterwards (no
 paint, sellotape, staples or paperclips etc)
- Take no longer than 1 hour (not including square-cutting)
- Children give written explanation of the birds features/adaptations

How to manage the competition in your school:

- 1. Register to take part in the competition by completing the GoogleForm link below.
- 2. Organise each class into pairs (you could do the challenge in a class or breakfast, after school or Science/Technology club).
- 3. Run the competition during British Science Week between 8-17th March 2019.
- 4. Choose a winning pair from each class; you can base your choice on the categories on page 2.
- 5. Take a clear photograph of the bird, accompanied by the children's written description of their bird: e.g. explanation for beak size, shape, legs, feet, wings and the environment it lives in, using the entry form in the challenge pack.
- 6. You can submit one winner from KS1 and one from KS2. Maximum of 2 entries per school.
- 7. Schools should email a photograph, accompanied by the children's written description (*This may be scribed for younger children*) to <u>vannessa.nash@setpointherts.org.uk</u> by the 5th April 2019 to enter the competition.

Brilliant Birds

Paper Engineering Challenge

The Challenge:

Create a Beautiful Bird using only recycled paper.

The rules:

Children must work individually or in pairs for this challenge, larger groups are not allowed. This challenge is to be completed in-school and not set as homework or an after school activity. (except as part of an after-school club)

Each pair may have 3 pieces of A4 card :

Sheet 1: Cut into squares of different sizes: cut from the template provided in the challenge pack or you can choose your own. We would suggest you photocopy it onto the card for pupils to cut out. This should be cut in advance, by older pupils if appropriate.

Sheet 2: This can be cut and used in any way desired for legs, wings, beaks, feathers, spots, decorations...... Sheet 3: This is to be used as a "baseplate" OR a piece of thread/string to hang a flying bird.

Only use pritt-stick style glue to make the creature, and only pen/pencil to decorate so it can be recycled afterwards (no paint, sellotape, paperclips etc)

Take no longer than 1 hour (not including square cutting).

Judging:

When you have run your challenge (during British Science Week, 8th-17th March 2019) send a photograph of your schools winning bird design & explanation sheet via email to <u>vannessa.nash@setpointherts.org.uk</u>

You may award class/year group/key-stage winners internally yourself, but maximum of 2 entries (for KS1 and KS2) can be submitted to us, to represent your school.

The entries will be judged in the following categories:


- Most imaginative bird
- Best engineered/constructed bird
- Best written explanation of adaptations for environment
