Adults verbose while agreed to their thoughts.


Trash on the floor that young child might have found,

Want to speak up but nobody listens, The elders announce that you are thinking. Each adult's mind has a brain that glistens, Artificial nonsense and this sinking.


The voice is ours so we can have speeches, Nothing can stop us from having the views. We have likes and dislikes like some peaches, There are opinions because we can choose.







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
