A representative from the Food Bank will come and speak to pupils and thank them for their support. They will tell pupils how the food donated will benefit the people they support.

### Secondary School – September 2019

Please be aware that the deadline for applications to secondary school is fast approaching. Parents will need to make an application online or on paper by the closing date of **Wednesday 31st October 2018** but Hertfordshire County Council recommend parents complete it by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2018, as there will be limited support available over the weekend for anyone having trouble applying.

### Attendance

Research has shown that attending school regularly contributes to good outcomes in learning for pupils. While we appreciate that pupils will get ill from time to time we expect pupils to be in school each day and arrive on time. School starts at 8:55 each morning.

### Stop Means Stop! Campaign

**Safeguarding School Crossing Patrols** 

Hertfordshire County Council has asked schools to make parents and carers aware of the above campaign. The campaign will run from **15**<sup>th</sup>-**26**<sup>th</sup> **October** and focuses on the law regarding school crossing patrols.

Failure to stop for the school crossing patrol is an offence and can result in a fine of up to £1000, three points on a driving licence, disqualification from driving or much worse — an avoidable road incident.

Stopping traffic is a difficult job and our school crossing patrols do this with a helping all pedestrians to safely cross the road.
