We continue to monitor pupils' attendance in school. Pupils are expected to be in school every day because research has shown that regular absence from school effects pupils' academic achievement. We have looked at the attendance of pupils and will invite some parents into school for a meeting about their child's attendance. These meetings are for the school to get an understanding of the ongoing absences, and to find ways forward so that pupils' attendance can improve. Parents are also reminded that leave taken to go abroad for any reason is classed as unauthorised leave. The school cannot authorise leave for pupils who are not in school.

Reception - September 2022

The on-line application system to apply for a place for Reception class in September 2022 is now open. We would like to remind parents who have children born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018 that they must apply for a place in Reception class, they do not automatically transfer from Nursery to Reception.

Application forms to apply for a place in Nursery, for children born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 are available from Thursday 6th January 2022. We plan to hold an Open Day On Thursday 13th January 2022 at 11:15am.


Article 38 - War and Armed Conflicts

Following is a gallery of work from different Year groups. They are voicing out their views for children, to live their lives peacefully and not be part of any bloody war!!



























Pantomime for Year 1 to Year 5
