A huge thank you to all the parents and carers who attended our Curriculum Evening yesterday. We had two sessions and they were well attended. The teachers in the school were introduced to parents and we talked about our priorities for the year. Any parents who were unable to attend the meeting can see their child's teacher for information. The curriculum booklets, curriculum overview and homework map were sent out yesterday via the school email system, Teachers2Parents.

The priorities this year include

- To move teaching and learning to Outstanding.
- To continue to improve attainment and progress levels of pupils in the school, especially in maths.
- To ensure that all groups perform as well as each other in reading, writing and maths.
- To make sure we always achieve good value for money, ensuring sufficiency in our budget.
- There will be a big drive on healthy eating this year. We will look at packed lunches and also want to encourage more pupils to try our tasty school dinners cooked by our own staff.
- To improve parent/school engagement by involving more parents in school life.
