Spanish Trip – Year 5

On Wednesday this week, Mrs Gonzales-Brew met the parents of the children in Year 5 who will be visiting Hornachuelos, Córdoba in Spain for one week from Monday 3rd June 2019. This has been made possible as a result of funding we received from a project called Erasmus +.

The Erasmus Programme (*EuRopean Community Action Scheme for the Mobility of University Students*) is a <u>European Union</u> (EU) <u>student exchange programme</u> established in 1987 and has now evolved into <u>Erasmus+</u>. This is a new programme combining all the EU's current schemes for education, training, youth and sport, which was started in January 2014. The project is part of a combined application by Bromet Primary School, Park Gate Primary School, Oxhey Wood Primary School and ourselves.

In addition to this we will also be applying for our international school award. As part of that the school will be taking part in 7 projects to gain the International school status. We will keep you updated on the projects and also how you, as parents, can support us.
