To gain the accreditation the school had to meet a number of standards, to a much enhanced level than for the Bronze award. The work undertaken by the teachers and pupils over the last year included learning the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and building an understanding of them for themselves and others.

### **Cornet Music Lessons Restarting**

Mr Fisher from Hertfordshire Music Service will restart cornets lesson for Year 3/4 Cedar class from next Wednesday. Hertfordshire Music Service has been given clear guidelines to follow and as a school we are able to completely comply with these to ensure safe play and social distancing for our pupils. Pupils will attend sessions in their bubble for up to 45 minutes. They will be issued with a cornet that will be cleaned and sanitised in advance, but most importantly, it will not be used by anyone else.



#### Clubs

We did not have a sufficient interest for the clubs offered by Premier Sport to parents and

therefore had to cancel. The school does not use Premier Sport anymore for PE lessons and regrettably we are not in a position to subsidise clubs as we have in the past. We understand that parents will be worried about pupils taking part in clubs in bigger year group bubbles. All providers need to provide the school with a risk assessment of their suggested activity and the school closely monitors these to ensure pupils are safely handled and that social distancing over 2 metres is maintained at clubs. Sport groups have also been given specific guidance to follow that we will implement with clubs. Watford Community and Education Trust have approached us and a letter will go



out on Monday. We will try and get 3 sports clubs going and will grow our club provision as the terms progress.
