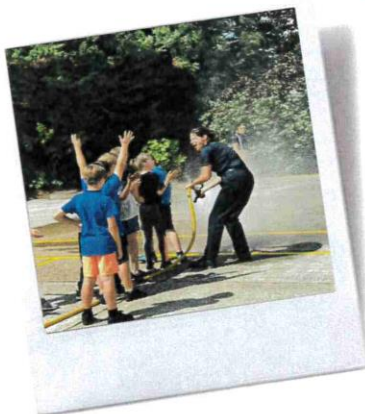

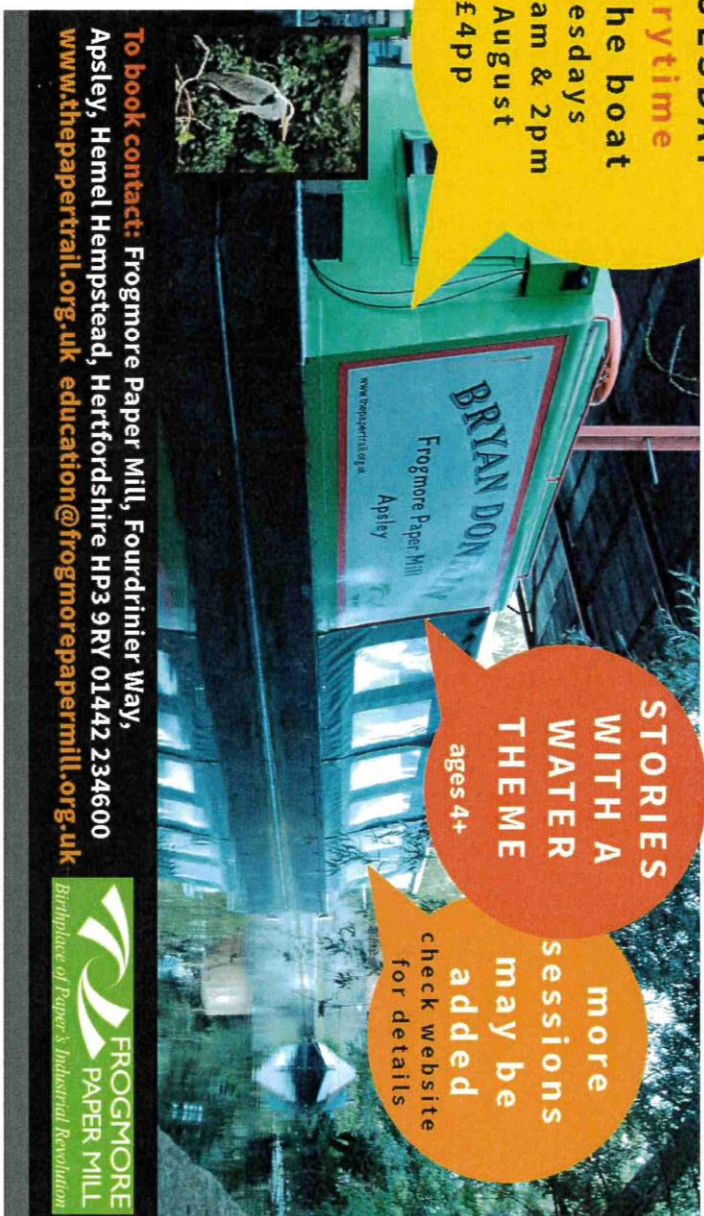

### STRENGTHENING FAMILIES

Alison Barnes, School Family Worker is now qualified to run Strengthening Families, Strengthening Communities parenting programmes.

She completed her training and successfully facilitated a 12 week course with local families to become fully accredited.

### FAMILIES FIRST ASSESSMENTS - EXPLAINED

The **CAF** (Common Assessment Framework) system was replaced by the **FFA** (Families First Assessment.)

This term should no longer be in use as new terminology has replaced this which we all need to familiarise ourselves with so we are all on the same page.

The **EHM** (Early Help Module) system is used to store **FFAs** and once completed and approved we begin to hold **TAF** (Team Around the Family) meetings to formulate a strategy and action plan to try to improve the family's situation. These can be attended by representatives from all the services involved with the family's case.

We can write and coordinate **FFAs** for you, and be the Lead Professional and chair the **TAF** meetings.
