### Be Bright, Be Seen

Following our Road Safety Week Assembly today, we would like to remind parents and carers about the Be Bright, Be Seen campaign currently running in Hertfordshire.

Visibility near and on roads is a key issue all year round and especially so in the winter months when days can be foggy and overcast. There are many things you can do to make sure that other road users can see you and your children. High visibility clothing and accessories are available from many outlets.

During the day, wearing bright or fluorescent clothing is best. Even a brightly coloured hat or scarf can help a driver to see you a few seconds earlier. At twilight and night time, reflective clothing or tape that is picked up in a vehicle's headlights works best. Fluorescent and reflective armbands can be worn over coats and clothing, and stickers, zip clips and reflectors can be used on school bags.
