Financial Support for pupils and families in 2021-22

Please see below for information about the generous financial support programme provided by Hertfordshire Music Service for instrumental music lessons. Support is for music tuition with HMS teachers during the 2021-22 academic year.

Parents/carers can initially apply directly to us, Hertfordshire Music Service, from **Wednesday 9th June** to **Wednesday 30th June 2021**. Schools can refer pupils in this period as well. Applications will be open all year, however this initial window will enable HMS to consider applications and confirm financial support to pupils and schools before the end of the summer term.

How do I make a school referral?

- If your school wants to refer a pupil directly to HMS to be considered for financial support, for example a child in the care of Hertfordshire County Council, or a pupil in exceptional circumstances, please email the details to music.remission@hertfordshire.gov.uk.
- This does not affect any separate subsidies that your school may offer pupils.

How do parents/carers apply for financial support?

- Renewals and new applications for financial support will initially be open between 9th June and 30th June 2021.

Covid-19 Testing - Lateral Flow Test and PCR Test

Parents are reminded that if their child shows symptoms of Coronavirus that they need to book a PCR Test, as set out in government guidance. Using a Lateral Flow Test to rule out Coronavirus is not sufficient because these tests work differently. The most accurate way to establish if someone has Coronavirus is through using a PCR Test. We kindly ask you always inform the school of the results please.

Coronavirus

We will keep our protocols and safeguarding the same as before half term and ask that parents continue to support us in staying safe.

Parents are reminded about Public Health England advice -

Pupils, staff and other adults must not come into the school if:

- they have one or more COVID-19 symptoms
- a member of their household (including someone in their support bubble or childcare bubble if they have one) has COVID-19 symptoms
- they are legally required to quarantine, having recently visited countries outside the Common Travel Area
- they have had a positive test
- have been in close contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19

In these circumstances

They must immediately cease to attend school and not attend for at least 10 days from the day after:

- the start of their symptoms
- the test date if they did not have any symptoms but have had a positive PCR or Lateral Flow Test

We must follow this process to ensure everyone's safety on site.
