It demonstrates the values that Jansen in Year 2 demonstrated while helping a member of the community. I think you would agree Jansen demonstrated all our school values and even though he is only in Year 2 modelled maturity, great kindness and community spirit in helping a stranger.

Dear Mr van Straaten,

I am writing to share some positive news about one of your students.

Yesterday afternoon, a man was taken seriously ill outside Chessbrook at around 3.30pm. A lady, Laura Mitchell and her son, Jansen (year 2) were first on the scene to assist the man and called for an ambulance.

A few of my staff and myself joined her to support the situation and carry out first aid. The situation became very serious at times as the man was very ill, and the ambulance did not arrive for a long time.

Throughout this time, Jansen very bravely provided assistance by directing passers by, keeping an eye out for the ambulance and looking after his mothers belongings while she was assisting with the situation.

The situation was scary at times and also occurred at the side of the road on Tolpits Lane at a very busy period.

Jansen was a real credit to himself, his family and your school. His behaviour and contributions were exemplary. I have prepared a certificate for him and have asked one of the outreach team to drop it into your school tomorrow. I would be very grateful if you could present the certificate to Jansen and congratulate him for his outstanding contributions.
