Secondary School - September 2020

Please be aware that the deadline for applications to secondary school is fast approaching. Parents will need to make an application online or on paper by the closing date of **Thursday 31st October 2019** but Hertfordshire County Council recommend parents complete it by Friday 25th October 2019, as there will be limited support available over the weekend for anyone having trouble applying.

Parents should apply online at www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/admissions or alternatively, if you cannot access the internet, you can request a printed version of the application form from Hertfordshire County Council - Customer Service Centre by calling 0300 123 4043.

School Meals

Pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free meal under the Universal Free School Meal scheme. If you are also entitled to Free School Meals we would like to encourage you to register even though you get a meal under the UFSM scheme. This allows the school to claim extra funding linked to your child that can be used on additional resources. Please register on the link below.

What else have the Senior Early Start team been doing:

As a team, we are continuing our work towards closing the achievement gap and supporting families in the area through Early Talk, Nurture Groups, home learning bags, 2 year development checks, supporting families in Stay & Play sessions, and assisting families with accessing free early education and school applications.

This term we will be Introducing a programme called Little Learners, which offers targeted support to parents who are signposted from their child's 10 month check from our Health colleagues, around their child's learning and development.

We will be sharing more about each of these programmes at our Network meetings.


