### Year 1 - Kings and Queens Workshop

Year 1 participated in a Kings and Queens workshop on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2020. They had the opportunity to learn about Kings and Queens across the ages from Cleopatra to Henry VIII. We explored the qualities of a good monarch and met famous monarchs across different historical eras. The children engaged in a variety of drama based activities to explore the timeline and understand the power of Kings and Queens throughout the ages. This led onto our Royal Afternoon, which consisted of a royal ball, banquet and castle competition.



### **Year 4 Indus Valley Workshop**

Cedar and Mulberry took a trip back 5000 years to the Indus Valley on Friday 7th February 2020. Building on from their learning this term, they worked with a Time Traveller to discover what happened at the beginnings of the civilisation and journeyed around Indus Valley towns and cities learning about the trade, farming and religious practices of this ancient civilisation.

Year 4 had great fun developing their knowledge further and becoming experts in the Indus Valley civilisation.


