I would like to start by welcoming everyone back after the summer break. It already seems a long time ago. Teachers and staff have been in over the holiday to prepare for the new academic year and we had a very productive INSET day on Monday. Pupils have settled quickly into their new classes and learning is well underway.

Sports Award

Holywell Primary School has been awarded the Bronze Sports Award; this is a big achievement for us. A lot of work has taken place over the last year to raise the profile of healthy living with pupils. We are very excited to receive this award as recognition of the work that we are doing and we are now working hard towards achieving the Gold Sports Award.



Catering

I am pleased to confirm we have successfully taken over the catering in school. Meals are now cooked by our own staff and we would like to welcome them to Holywell Primary School. We have a much wider range of meals on offer to our pupils and the cost of each meal is £2.20 per day, £11. 00 per week. The price of our meals is very reasonable compared to the other catering companies within



Hertfordshire. Each day we offer a meat option, a vegetarian option and a halal option. If pupils do not like the options on offer they can always opt for a jacket potato. Parents of pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Universal Free School scheme. Unless pupils have specific allergies we would expect them to take up this very good offer. We kindly ask you to discuss your child's dietary needs with their Class Teacher if they not taking up this free school meal offer.

Cashless

As you are no doubt aware, the school has moved to a cashless system which will help us be more efficient in the use of our resources and staffing. The system, called "School Money," has been very well received by the many parents who have been using it over the past year. The office staff have been helping parents who have experienced problems accessing the system and are more than happy to assist parents with on-going issues.



Attendance and Punctuality

This year, one our priorities will be to ensure that pupils arrive to school on time. Punctuality has been okay this week, but unfortunately we still had a few children arriving late. We would like to remind you that school starts each day at 8:55am, this means that children should arrive in school, at the latest, 8:50am. Arrival to school on time is pertinent to children's success in school and research has proven this. If pupils arrive on time they are calmer and concentration levels are better. It also means they do not miss the start of their lessons which commence immediately after registration.

Even though we do not authorise leave for children during term time we still have many parents who take their children abroad or out of school for various reasons. This unauthorised leave means parents could be issued with a fixed term penalty notice by the local authority or even face court action. The school has the authority to remove pupils from their roll if they have not returned to school within 10 days. The term dates for 2018 – 2019 have been included in this newsletter to enable parents to plan their holidays.

La Jolie Ronde French Programme – Autumn 2018

Dear Parents of Holywell School,

We are delighted to offer places for La Jolie Ronde French Programme Autumn 2018 which will run during lunchtime from week commencing 10th September, 2018. Our programme has won the What's On for Junior Awards for the last 4 years.

This is what La Jolie Ronde classes provide:

- A structured and progressive language course which holds an Early Language Learning badge awarded by the DTI and supports the National Curriculum Scheme of Work for England and Wales. This means an independent assurance of quality with content which is relevant and works towards academic achievements.
- An excellent accent for the children to develop as all teachers are native speakers as well as DBS certified. At a young age, it is possible to make best use of a child's ability to listen and copy new sounds, intonation and gesture. Learning, when they are most receptive and uninhibited.
- Small classes so your child can receive plenty of individual attention and learn with children of his/her own age. New children joining are integrated fully with recycling of content at several stages.
- To achieve a high standard through activities that are interesting, rewarding and fun.
- An awareness of France, its geography and culture.
- Termly reports on your child's progress and French certificates awarded on completion of each stage.

La Jolie Ronde classes run separately from those offered in the curriculum to children at KS2. The programme is designed to enhance learning skills and to challenge the children, which means that they not only **excel** in languages, but also become more receptive to learning in other subjects. Classes are offered at the rate of **£6.50** per 30 minute sessions, paid termly in advance. An integral part of the course is the fun activity book and interactive CD or Smartphone App, to help with your child's learning at a cost of £15 which lasts for a full year until the next level is reached.

Places will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis.

- Siblings <u>must</u> be accompanied by parent/s to <u>all sessions</u>.
- Parent will need to arrange alternative care and accommodation for the child with SEND.
- There will be simple fun family tasks to take home to support learning (taking about 10 minutes per week)
