#### Welcome back

We can support pupils eligible for Free School Meals with food parcels. We are also able to support pupils accessing online learning, while working online and other learning. This support is

available to all our families, so please do not hesitate to contact us. Parents are reminded that all remote learning is taking place through Google Classroom. Each child has a username and password to access this learning platform. Each pupil in Year 1 up to Year 6 can expect at least two live lessons each day. Currently these lessons are staggered as we know some families are sharing devices. Please see the timetable below. It is sometimes necessary for teachers to move a lesson but parents will be notified in advance when this is necessary.
