Supporting Your Child in Reading (SEND)

At 9:15am on Monday, 12th June, Mrs Keshiro will be presenting to parents of pupils with SEND about the importance of reading. She will share strategies that parents can use to support their children with their reading. All parents are invited to attend. This meeting will take place in the infant hall.

Phonics Screening

Year 1 and 2 pupils who reached the required threshold, will be completing the phonics screening test next week.

Pupils have been working hard in Read, Write, ink, to prepare themselves for this test. We wish them all the best for completing this. Their Teachers know that tests can be a stressful time for children, so will work closely with them to ensure that they are calm and confident.

Pupils across the school were assessed this week so that they can be regrouped for Read Write Ink. I am happy to report that pupils across the school are continuing to make good progress in the programme.

Multiplication Check

Pupils in Year 4, will be taking part in a multiplication check. This is a national test, similar to the phonics screening check. Good luck Year 4!

Next week, children in Years 1, 3, 4 and 5 will be completing our end of year assessments for this academic year. The reading and writing assessment will inform teachers' judgement in their end of year reports.
