Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back everyone, it has been a great start to the new academic year. All pupils seem to have settled well and have enjoyed their first week back at school.

We have updated our Covid-19 visitor protocol which is on our website. Visitors who are working with children are allowed into school. Parents are allowed in by appointment only, and we ask that you continue to wear a face covering. Thank you for your continued co-operation in this matter.

School Opening Times

We would like to remind parents the school gates are open in the morning between 8:45am and 9:05am and between 3:05pm and 3:30pm in the afternoon. Parents who allow their children to walk to school on their own are reminded that pupils cannot get access to the school site before 8:45am. Teachers will be available on the playground in the mornings between 8:45am and 8:50am when they will take children to the classrooms. Anyone arriving between 8:50am and 8:55am when school starts, are to make their way straight to the classroom.

Nursery

Here we all are at Holywell Nursery! Our new nursery children are here together now, ready to begin their learning fun, as you can see. This week we have been learning new songs, new games and new ways and everybody has had new experiences, including Mrs Hewett and Miss Akbar. We planned a party picnic for today, but then it rained. Never mind, we made fabulous party hats to take home with our take-away picnic boxes. We'll try again soon!

















Reception

In Reception, we are getting familiar with our classmates and our classroom environment.





Sycamore

In Sycamore this week, we began with creating our own class rules, setting behavioural expectations in the classroom and exploring the areas and learning where the resources are. The children were very happy to share their summer adventures with each other and are working towards writing a letter to Mr van Straaten to tell him all about the fun they had.





Hazel

In Hazel Class this week we have been focusing on routines, handwriting and place value. The children have really impressed the adults in the class with their determination in writing using their 'fancy' cursive letters. Well done Hazel!

Hawthorn

In Hawthorn class this week we have been learning to write a recount of the events of our summer holidays. We have used the time connectives first, next, then and finally to help us sequence the events.

In maths we have been learning to regroup numbers up to 20 and revising our number bonds to 10 and 20. Everyone has settled really well.



Rowan

This week in Rowan Class, the children have settled into their new classroom and created a set of rules for everyone to follow. In English the children have been focusing on letter writing, they have written some fantastic letters about their summer holidays and Year 3. In Maths, we have been looking at place value and how to use this to solve problems.



Cedar

This week in Cedar class we have focused on writing and editing informal letters. In Maths, we have also started to partition and regroup numbers (up to and beyond 1000).



Mulberry

This week Mulberry class have settled in really well. In English we focused on writing a letter to Mr Van Straaten. In maths we recapped place value and dienes. We also started our science lesson on animals which was very engaging.

Elder

In English this week Elder have been writing letters detailing their summer holidays. We have been recapping the differences between formal and informal letters and practicing varying the start of our sentences. In maths we have been working on place value with numbers containing up to 7 digits! Our lessons have included ordering, comparing and ensuring that we are able to write out numbers using digits and in words.



Chestnut

This week in English we have been learning about the structure and features of informal and formal letters. We have been writing letters to Mr van Straaten about our experiences over the summer holidays. In Maths we have been learning about the place value of both four digit and five digit numbers. The children have been ordering and comparing numbers using partitioning. They have also been rounding five digit numbers to the nearest thousand.







Elm

In Year 6 we have been focusing on setting out expectations for the new year. In maths we have focused on Place Value, while in English we have looked at Features of letters and applying them to our own writing.

Birch

In Year 6 this week the children have been focusing on the features of a formal letter and applied their learning by writing a letter to the class teacher regarding their goals and expectations for this year. In maths children revised the place values of numbers; ordered and compared numbers up to a million, including decimals. We have also been setting up our class charter.

ARTICLE 29 (goals of education)

Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full. It must encourage the child's respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, their own and other cultures, and the environment.

Respect

We had our whole school assembly this morning. For whole school assemblies we will stagger pupils' attendance, ensuring we can space the children out and have good ventilation throughout the hall. Our school focus will be Respect this half term and made links to the Article 29 from the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child. We will be linking these rights to our school themes as we work toward the second part of our Gold award.

Transforming Travel in Watford consultation by Watford Borough Council



Last year, residents and organisations in the town were asked about their key transport priorities. Issues around the environment, congestion, road safety and lack of cycling infrastructure were frequently raised.

Their feedback has been used to develop the draft Transforming Travel in Watford Strategy which is outlined on this website: www.futuretravelwatford.com. This sets out how Watford Borough Council and Hertfordshire County Council intend to address these challenges with specific actions www.futuretravelwatford.com/plans.

Watford Borough Council have now launched a formal consultation on the strategy and key actions and want to hear from residents, visitors, businesses and stakeholders to refine these.

Transport produces the most greenhouse gases in the UK, and in our stand against climate change the strategy sets out how we plan to make it easier and greener for people to get around Watford, particularly by walking, cycling and using public transport.

Watford Borough Council would welcome your views on our proposals to transform travel in Watford. The survey is open from 16 August to 8 October 2021.
