Subject Area	Content
Literacy	<ul> <li>Communication and language:</li> <li>Maintains attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activity.</li> <li>Beginning to hear rhyme and rhythm in words</li> <li>Able to follow a story without pictures or props.</li> <li>Beginning to understand how and why questions</li> <li>Reading and writing:</li> <li>Links sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet.</li> <li>Uses vocabulary and forms of speech that are increasingly influenced by their experiences of books.</li> <li>Gives meaning to marks they make.</li> <li>Library books will contilnue to be given out and changed every Friday.</li> </ul>
Maths	<ul> <li>Numbers: <ul> <li>Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.</li> <li>Counts out up to six objects from a larger group.</li> <li>Selects the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Shapes, space and measure: <ul> <li>Begin to use the language of capacity such as full, empty.</li> <li>Recognises basic 2D shapes.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Knowledge and understanding of the world	<ul> <li>People and Communities:</li> <li>Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience.</li> <li>Recognises and describes special times or events for family or friends.</li> <li>The World:</li> <li>Developing an understanding of growth, decay and changes over time.</li> <li>Shows care and concern for living things and the environment.</li> </ul>







	<ul> <li>Technology:</li> <li>Shows skill in making toys work by pressing parts or lifting flaps to</li> </ul>

Music	Voices: Increasing children's confidence to use their voice and independent singing.
PE	<ul> <li>Travels with confidence and skill around balancing and climbing equipment.</li> <li>Shows increasing control over an object in pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it.</li> <li>Uses a pencil and holds it effectively to form recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed.</li> <li>Understand that equipment and tools must be used safely.</li> </ul>
PSHE	<ul> <li>Can describe self in positive terms and talk about abilities.</li> <li>Understands that own actions affect other people, for example, becomes upset or tries to comfort another child when they realise they have upset them.</li> <li>Initiates conversations, attends to and takes account of what others say.</li> <li>Explains own knowledge and understanding, and asks appropriate questions of others.</li> </ul>
