Power of Reading	This term our book is called 'One Day On Our Blue Planet In The
	Savannah' by Ella Bailey. Our ICT, Music, Science and Topic lessons
	will be linked to this scheme to help support our writing in English. In
	particular our Science lessons lend themselves to our Power of
	Reading book as the children will be learning about MRS GREN and
	will use this information combined with their understanding of a
	Savannah animal to create a cyclical diagram of a lion from the
	Savannah, our topic, in English.
English	Spoken Language: To ask relevant questions to extend their

	Reading: To apply phonetical knowledge to read aloud and
	understand the meaning of unfamiliar words. To identify words and
	phrases that link events in the story. The children will be applying
	inference and recall skills to answer comprehension questions
	before retelling the story.
	Writing: To compose sentences using a range of sentence structures.
	To orally rehearse a sentence or a sequence of sentences. To write
	own version of a traditional tale, using a clear structure.
	Spelling, vocabulary, grammar, and punctuation: To use
	subordination and co-ordination to link events, cause and effect. To
	use expanded noun phrases for description and specification. To use
	progressive form of verbs in the present and past tense. To use
	capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to
	demarcate sentences.

Science	Working scientifically:

	Science content: living things and their habitats (Topic)
	-Identify the processes of living things.
	- Recognise that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways
	-Explore and use classification keys to help group, identify and name
	a variety of living things in their local and wider environment
	Linked to our Power of Reading book we will also be exploring the
	habitats of animals within the Savannah. The children will begin by
	learning about the typical habitats of the world before extending
	their learning to learn about the habitats within the Savannah.
	Within these lessons we will be using our book as a stimulus for
	developing our understanding on animals and their life processes.
	The children will apply their understanding of life processes to create
	cyclical diagram in English.
ICT	In ICT this term our topic is coding. We will be using our scheme
ICT	called Purple Mash to help the children understand the foundations
	of coding. The children will be creating a simple coding program for
	an animal from the Savannah.
	We will also focus on online safety and will be helping the children to
	understand how search engines work and how to create emails.
	Within these areas they will learn about how messages are shared
	online and the feelings that come with receiving unkind messages.
	They will also learn about the potential dangers of search engines.
Art and Design	The children will receive an Art lesson each week from our specialist
	Art teacher, which will focus on different art element each week.
Geography	This term the children are focusing on Great Britain. They will be
Geography	focusing on the different countries within GB, locating them on maps
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	and then learning about their key features. They will develop an
	understanding of their culture, landmarks and important
	characteristics to enable them to identify key similarities and
	differences within the countries.
	Linked to our Power of Reading Book we will also be comparing the
	climate in GB with the Savannah setting. The children will also be
	creating a 3D landmark for the different GB countries and the
	Savannah and will then compare the settings.
Music	Children will embark on their Charanga journey our focus song is
Wasic	'Hands, feet, heart' which is based on South African Music.
PE	This term the children will have the chance to take part in a PE
• •	Programme called 'Premier League Primary Stars' which is run by
	sports coaches at Watford FC. This programme is designed to
	develop the children's physical skills in sport as well as their social,
	emotional and thinking skills. The children will also take part in
	Holywell Explorers, which will develop a range of skills such as
	communication and teamwork.
Spanish	The children will continue to develop their knowledge and
Spa mon	understanding of Spanish through the Modern Foreign Language
	teacher. For example, they will learn about counting and colours.
PSHE	As a school our scheme for this term is New Beginnings. The children
1 3112	will receive a lesson every week around this theme, which will also
	be linked to our weekly Monday assemblies. We will also be learning
	the differences between boys and girls.
RE	The children will be looking at different religious symbols and their
	meanings and then comparing these across different religions.
